

REGULATION E - 4, 1998

RULES GOVERNING BROILER CHICK PURCHASES AND SALES BY BROKER DEALERS AND OTHERS

(Revised December 2011)

1. No person in the Province of Ontario shall purchase Ontario produced broiler chicks from anyone who is not licensed by the Commission as a hatchery or broker dealer.
2. No person shall act as a broker dealer except under the authority of a licence issued by the Commission. A licence will be issued annually at the discretion of the Commission upon receipt of a duly completed application form and a fee of \$100.00 plus applicable taxes. Any broker dealer licence may subject to conditions as determined by the Commission.
3. A hatchery engaged in the marketing of broiler chicks shall be deemed not to be a broker dealer and shall not be required to obtain a broker dealer licence for that purpose.
4. All licence holders marketing broiler chicks out of Province require an Interprovincial and Export Licence issued in advance by the Canadian Hatching Egg Producers. All licence holders must comply with all terms and conditions of the licence.
5. All licence holders who purchase broiler chicks not produced in Ontario for marketing require an Interprovincial and Export Licence issued in advance, by the Canadian Hatching Egg Producers. All licence holders must comply with all terms and conditions of the licence.
6. No broker dealer shall be permitted to market broiler chicks to broiler producers.
7. No broiler producer shall utilize the services of a broker dealer in connection with the purchase of broiler chicks in the Province of Ontario.
8. No broker dealer shall be permitted to market hatching eggs.
9. A broker dealer marketing broiler chicks to other than a licensed hatchery or a licensed broker dealer shall limit each transaction to a small lot and to a small flock grower.
